Helped with a town hall presentation for our 5th and 6th grade students. I then went into the classrooms after this presentation and answered questions as well as discussed the main points with students. Gave a guidance lesson about bullying to our 5th and 6th grade students. Ran a staff raffle using our Lauffer bucks to reward teachers who give out the must bucks to our students. Worked to craft and update 504 plans for students.

LAUFFER (4-6) (Part 2): As part of my shared responsibilities, I did hallway observations between classes and helped to monitor the cafeteria every day during lunch. Gave students a survey in which they could give suggestions on how to improve our school climate. Run and manage the PBIS student store at lunch time. 504 coordinator for 5th and 6th grade. Attend IEP and CFT meetings. Bens bells kind campus coordinator. K-12 counselor district meetings. Hosted a monthly student of the month breakfast where students were recognized for their outstanding behavior. Parents also attended the student of the month breakfast. Organized and planned a move-up day for our incoming 5th grade students.
